- Growing demand for solutions/action
- More mayors and elected officials calling for change
- Increased media focus on state/local friction
- Voters say it's time for a home rule update



- Emerging research documenting the consequences of the misuse of preemption
- Cross-issue coalitions active in multiple states
- Education campaigns already in play in multiple states

Need to update HR to meet demands of today and tomorrow

#### Need a deeper, structural fix



### **Recruiting champions**

Countering preemption bills; advancing repeal and affirming local authority



# **Creating demand for home rule reform**

Make this a conversation about the power of people, not the power of government to shape their community

Local officials need the power to act on their decisions.



Use compelling language that explains both value of HR and need for reform

### They decide.

### Use the current session to remind allies and public:

"This is why we need to update/reaffirm home rule powers."
